



PRIVACY POLICY

As part of the interactions that Denham Martin (**DM**) of Denham Martin Tax Law (**DMTL**) may have with you (**you**) as a client DM may collect and hold personal information (**personal information**) about you. DM is committed to protecting the privacy of that personal information.

Personal information

Personal information is information about you as an identifiable individual and includes things like your name, address, email address, and telephone number. DM may collect information of this type when you visit DMTL's website, instruct DM to represent you (or a client, if you are representing the client), or when you otherwise interact with DMTL.

If you do not provide DMTL with personal information that is requested then DM may not be able to provide his legal services to you.

Purposes for which DMTL may use your personal information

DMTL will collect and hold your personal information in accordance with applicable privacy law and will only use your personal information for the following purposes:

- Engaging with you as a client and providing services to you
- Checking legal or commercial conflicts
- With your consent providing you with publications
- When you apply to be employed, or contracted, by DM (e.g. checking references)
- Complying with DM's legal obligations (e.g. requesting identity information required by anti-money laundering and countering financing of terrorism legislation)
- Carrying out DM's internal business processes (e.g. invoicing and debt recovery)
- Disclosures that are required to be made by DM with third parties (e.g. hosting and data storage providers)

DM will not use or disclose your personal information for any other purpose without your consent, unless DM is authorised or required to do so by the Law Society's Rules of Professional Conduct or by an applicable law.
